The Dutch Shepherd National Specialty is open to ALL AKC FSS registered Dutch Shepherds at least 4 months old, including spayed and neutered.

No experience necessary. Basic dog manners is all that is needed. Judging will be "Dutch style", without stacking. Dress is casual.

Owners will be given a written, FCI-style, critique of their dog.

This specialty show is a non-sanctioned show, no CM points will be awarded to winners.

Dogs will be judged based on the AKC breed standard and judged by sex and variety. The three winning dogs of each variety will be judged for Best in Show.

There will be other shows on the show grounds, plus, the Purina Center is open to the public. If your dog is not people or dog friendly, please make sure it is safely crated while on the grounds.

Prong collars and electronic collars are not allowed on the show grounds.

Non-Entered dogs are not permitted inside the building.

Please pick up after your dogs at all times, including at hotels.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This event is open to all Dutch Shepherds dogs registered with the American Kennel Club Foundation Stock Service (FSS) who are four (4) months of age or older. Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in Open Shows except if they are handling a dog that they own. Professional handlers are defined according to the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* Chapter 3, Section 7.

Dogs should be physically sound. No dog shall be judged if it is taped, bandaged, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this show, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Belgian Laekenois Association and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Belgian Laekenois Association reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Belgian Laekenois Association or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on show grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Show Committee.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive one-half hour prior to judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official Entry Form for this event.
